Research Question with Hyphotesis that will be the basis to solve the research question (*o objeto da pesquisa possui um problema científico, que aqui será caracterizado)

Qual é a questão que gerará o objetivo a ser resolvido? Escrever em forma de pergunta. Deve haver UM problema de pesquisa delimitado. Foco é a chave do problema. E hipóteses (positiva, negativa, neutra), que servirão de base para solucionar o problema, são tentativas de confirmar, refutar ou alterar o problema.

General and Specific Aims

O objetivo geral define a pesquisa, delimitando-a, e os específicos especificam o objetivo principal, em forma de etapas, ou partes que acabarão gerando o objetivo principal. Na prática, os objetivos específicos serão as bases dos capítulos da dissertação.

Theoretical Basis

Discute a teoria-base (uma ou várias ou um teórico) que será aplicado ao problema para resolvêlo. Aqui, pode-se fazer uma rápida revisão de literatura a respeito do objeto da pesquisa

Methodology
